Race Weekend Safety and Security Reminders

The safety of our participants, volunteers, and spectators is our top priority. Please follow these guidelines to ensure a safe weekend for all:

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS:

Obey all directions from race, medical, and police officials. If you see something suspicious, alert law enforcement or call 911.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE:

Medical staff and volunteers are stationed along the course. If you or someone else needs help, notify officials right away.

BAG INSPECTIONS:

Only clear bags are permitted for gear check. Non-clear bags are subject to inspection. Items left at the start line will be collected and donated or discarded.

PARTICIPANT ACCESS:

Only registered participants with bibs are allowed on the course and in secure areas, including start and finish lines.

POLICE & VOLUNTEERS:

Uniformed police and volunteers will be on-site to keep you safe. Please follow their directions and thank them for their service.

COMMUNICATION:

Emergency updates, delays, or status changes will be shared via text. Keep your phone with you on race day.

EVENT ALERT SYSTEM

There will be flags at the medical tents on-course to indicate race conditions.



Green

Good conditions for racing



Yellow

Moderate risk of heat injury, consider slowing your pace



Red

High risk of heat injury or serious environmental condition



Black

Race has been canceled

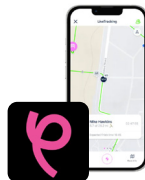

Race Day Parking and Directions



We suggest parking near the finish line by Sawyer Point. Surface lots on Eggleston Ave. are closest to the finish line and approximately 0.7 miles to the start walking north on Eggleston towards the casino. The Sawyer Point parking lot on the south side of Riverside Dr./E. Pete Rose Way will not be open for parking on race day.

FROM I-71 SOUTHBOUND, use the Gilbert Ave exit and proceed straight off the exit. Turn right onto Court St., left onto Reedy St. and then left onto Eggleston Ave. to proceed to the surface lots along Eggleston Ave.

FROM I-75 SOUTHBOUND, exit at 5th St. and continue through downtown. Take Sentinel, right on Eggleston Ave to the surface lots.

FROM I-71/75 NORTHBOUND, exit at 5th St. and continue through downtown. Take Sentinel, right on Eggleston Ave to the surface lots.

FROM THE EAST, come in via Columbia Parkway and exit at Eggleston Ave. Turn left or right off the exit onto Eggleston Ave. to the surface lots.

HOW TO JOIN

Stop by the Pace Team booth at the Bee-U-Tique Expo on Friday, October 10 to get information. There is no fee to join, and it is not mandatory to register. Any participant is welcome to join on race day.

FIND A PACE TEAM ON RACE DAY

Look for the Pace Team signs in the appropriate corrals at the starting line. To avoid the last-minute crowds and congestion, plan to meet your pace team at least 30 minutes prior to the start.

GEAR/BAGGAGE CHECK

Participants in both the Half Marathon and 4 Miler may check a clear bag near the start line of the race. Yellow school buses will be parked on Court St. just south of the casino beginning at 6 a.m. and must be checked in by 7:30 for the half and 8 a.m. for the 4 Miler.

The baggage buses will be transported to Sawyer Point where you can retrieve your bag after the race and will be available until noon.

"HIVE" START CORRALS

The assigned Hive for both the Half Marathon and 4 Miler will be indicated on your race bib with both a color and a letter.

Please line up next to the feather banner with the color/letter that matches the one on your bib. Men participating in either of the races, and any women wishing to run with them, will start in the back (Hive F) for both races.



Course Support

HYDRATION STATIONS

There will be water and Gatorade at 11 fluid stations on the Half Marathon course, and 2 fluid stations on the 4 Miler course, with Gatorade served first.

PARTICIPANT EXPERIENCE ZONES

Energy gel will be available just before Mile 9 on the Half Marathon course.

There will be a number of participant experience zones on the course that will be giving away items such as Twizzlers, jellybeans, oranges and other fun items (see Queen's Jesters on our website for a full list).

PORTABLE RESTROOMS

There will be portable restrooms at the Start and Finish Lines and near every fluid station along the course.

MILE MARKERS/DIGITAL CLOCKS

A mile marker sign will be placed at the beginning of each mile. Digital clocks will be placed at the halfway point of the Half Marathon and the finish line. Timing mats will be at the Start and Finish lines as well as the halfway point of the Half Marathon.

MEDICAL SUPPORT/RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Our medical team is stationed at four locations along the course, with a fully equipped medical facility at the finish line, courtesy of UC Health, staffed by a team of local healthcare professionals until 12:00 p.m.

The Medical Staff and Marathon officials have the right to withdraw any participant from the race that appears in distress or at risk. Please cooperate if you are asked to go for a checkup.

If you are unable to finish the race for any reason, please notify a race official of your bib number so that medical personnel are aware.

COURSE TIME LIMIT

For your safety and to follow course re-opening times, there is a four-hour course limit for the Half Marathon, which is approximately 18 minute per mile pace. Anyone that is unable to maintain that pace, on either the Half Marathon or 4 Miler course, may be asked to move to the sidewalk to finish the race.

We appreciate your compliance with these time restrictions and look forward to seeing you at the finish line!





Finish Line



All participants will receive the coveted finisher medal and have access to a mylar blanket. All finishers will pass through the Kroger Recovery Area, to receive food and refreshments provided by Kroger.

Access to the Kroger Recovery Area is limited to participants only.

Green Team volunteers will be there to assist you with our recycling efforts.

Participants can meet up with family and friends at the Michelob Ultra Victory Party at Sawyer Point! Celebrate your accomplishment with food, fun, live music, and sunflowers courtesy of our friends at Kroger. Refuel with a delicious First Watch breakfast featuring pancakes, sunrise bowls, and coffee and then redeem your bib tickets for a complimentary Skyline Chili Cheese Coney and drink. Don't miss the chance to relax, refuel, and celebrate—you've earned it!

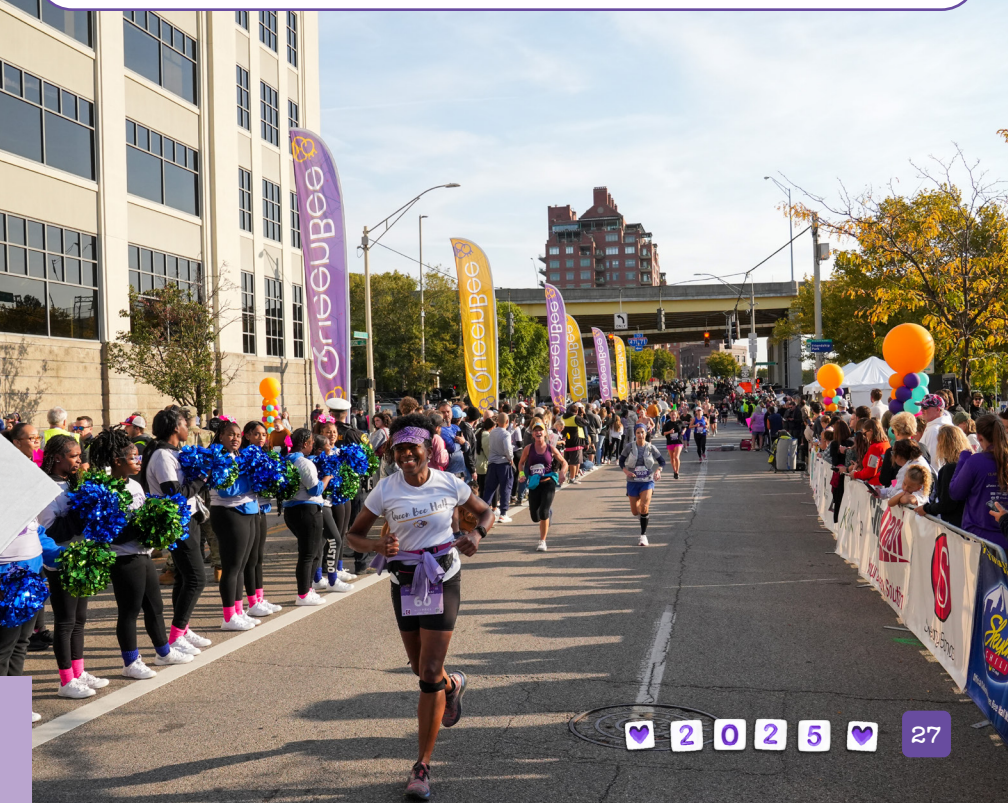
That participant is now loaded on your app and you can track and follow them throughout the race.
